Entertainment Packages

P1. Traditional or Contemporary Solo didgeridoo performance

Description: One Performer in full traditional costume, performing traditional or contemporary didgeridoo sounds and rhythms. Duration: 1-45 minutes

P2. Welcome to country and Traditional Aboriginal Smoking Ceremony

Description: consisting of 5 performers. A song man, a didgeridoo player, elder and 2 dancers, performing the blessings of the smoke and traditional songs. Welcome to country, farewells, Open and Closing ceremonies. Duration: 1-20 minutes

P3. Mini Corroboree Dance Group

Description: consisting of 5 performers. A song man, a didgeridoo player and 3 dancers. Traditional authentic Aboriginal song and dance show. Traditional fire making ceremony demonstration. Each song tells a story and will be explained to the audience. Audience participation and photo opportunity. Duration: 1-45minutes

P4. Corroboree Performance.

Description: consisting of 6 performers. A song man, a didgeridoo player, an elder, and 4 dancers. Traditional authentic Aboriginal song and dance show, along with a smoking ceremony, traditional fire making. Audience participation and photo opportunity. Duration: 45 minutes

P5. Corroboree mixed with Contemporary show

Description: consisting of 7 performers. A song man, a didgeridoo player, an elder, and 4 dancers. Traditional authentic Aboriginal song and dance, Traditional fire making and smoking ceremony plus an additional contemporary dance and didgeridoo show.

Duration: 60 minutes, (show will be broken down in 3, 20 minute segments)

KOOMURRI WORKSHOPS

1. ABORIGINAL ROCK ART CLASS:

Learn the symbols of traditional and contemporary Aboriginal art and how to create a story with these symbols. We also discuss about colour and why we use traditional and contemporary colours. A rock is supplied to each student and he/she can create their own story for them to keep.

2. ABORIGINAL SONG AND DANCE:

We demonstrate traditional songs and their meanings, the importance of clap sticks, didgeridoo and vocals. Each student has the opportunity for their face to be painted as an Aboriginal. We then get the students involved with our dancing.

3. ARTIFACTS, WEAPONRY AND BUSH SURVIVAL:

A demonstration of traditional weapons and artifacts are displayed for the students to see and hold. We briefly explain what each is used for and how important it was back then for survival.

4. BOOMERANG AND SPEAR THROWING: (if space is available and if weather is ok)

Different uses for different types of boomerangs are taught. We then demonstrate how to throw a returning boomerang. Also, discuss about the importance of spears for survival. Each student can get the opportunity to throw a returning boomerang.

5. DIDGERIDOO WORKSHOP:

Our didgeridoo master demonstrates various complex sounds with his didgeridoo. He will teach the role that the didgeridoo plays back then and now. He will then teach the students how to play.

All equipment including, rocks, face paint, traditional artifacts, weapons, boomerangs, spears, didgeridoos, paints and brushes are supplied by Koomurri.

The day will start off with a traditional Aboriginal song and dance "corroboree" and traditional welcoming. We will then rotate the school all day in 4 of the above classes 30-40 minute rotations. We will finish off with a farewell "corroboree" involving the kids and teachers.
